Vice Chair - (DF) told the Group that we should be aiming for Green Flag Status. He said that he would try and find out from the Council what we had to do to get this status. It has been discussed many times but we have not moved forward in establishing what we have to do

Secretary - Nothing to report

Treasurer – (AH) told the Group that we had five thousand pounds in the bank and the accounts would be prepared and ready for the next meeting

Council – There was no representative from the Council and no report had been sent.

Events - (BG) told the Group that the Bat Walk, which has been very popular over the years with children and parents, had to be cancelled because the footballers took all the parking spaces and the parents had to turn their cars round and leave, There is another Bat Walk on 20th September so it is hoped that this event will be able to take place

(CH) told the Group that Sonia and Sandra had put a lot of work into the event on 27th August. Everyone who attended enjoyed that event very much but (SV) felt that the numbers were down on last year. The Group felt that one of the reasons was that Sandwell Valley held an event at the same time. It was also bank holiday.

Environment – Members of the Swan Watch told the Group that the island needed emptying and clearing out.

(DF) told the Group that he was interested in purchasing some 'woodland faces' to put in the woods and create a 'face trail'.

Any Other Business – Joe saw the Developer on 28th July and the following is his report

- **1.** History of House on a plaque Will be funded by the English Heritage **ongoing**
- 2. The care of the Mulberry Tree has been passed to the Tree Gang
- 3. There has been no movement on behalf of the Council to sort out the Rose Beds. The Group would like the plans to be finalised and the area tidied up. COUNCIL ACTION
- 4. Sunish confirmed that the plans for the main avenue path had been abandoned and it had been decided to make the disabled parking next to the house. It was agreed by the Group to pursue all possibilities to get the path installed. One idea put forward was to approach a 'charity arm' of a large waste company and see if they would be willing to do it.
- 5 The second goal post has not been installed properly. **COUNCIL ACTION NEEDED**
- 6 (JM) has organised another meeting with the Developer on 13th October.
- 8 In April Andy Tromans walked round the Park with members of the Friends Group. He noted the suggested places for the fencing and said that five bins needed replacing, several

needed repairing and some could be re-sited - Ongoing

- 9 The surface of the children's play area is lifting and is considered dangerous by the Friends The work is planned to be done Ongoing 2016 Council
- 10 The notice boards need keeping up to date and repairing where necessary.It was mentioned at a previous meeting that the foggy Perspex would be replaced by Sandwell MBC This has been passed to Gary Bell . The old notices need to be taken out of the Notice Board. COUNCIL ACTION
- 11 The Box Conifers that have died need taking out of the flower beds. Council
- 12 (SV) pointed out that there is a broken drain cover that is starting to sink in the Pavilion Car Park Council Action
